**AFTER-SCHOOL CLUBS Autumn 2024 – Please read carefully**

We are now able to share our Autumn club details. We would like to thank all of our teachers for providing the children with these opportunities during their free time.

Clubs will continue to be offered on a first come first served basis, meaning that if there is not enough space in your child's chosen club then we will try to allocate them their second choice.

Attached to this letter is a list of the after-school clubs available to children from Year 1 to Year 6. Please note the following points relating to all clubs:

1. Clubs will run from Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October until Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November.
2. Clubs will end at 4.15pm unless stated otherwise and, as usual, there will be no charge.
3. Children are expected to attend their chosen club every week and we would appreciate it if you could notify their class teacher, and the school office if your child is unable to attend for any reason.
4. In an effort to accommodate everyone, a maximum of one club per child will be allocated.
5. Today you will be able to make your club selection using a Google Form. Please complete this form [here](#) by 9am on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September. If you require a paper version then please contact the School Office. This form will be available from **4pm today**.
6. Please note: it will not be possible to exceed the maximum number for each club. **To secure a place, please complete your form as soon as possible and by 9am on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September at the latest. Late applications will NOT be accepted.**
7. All **sports** clubs will be dismissed/collected from our school hall; access will be via the Key Stage 2 playground gate. All teacher-led clubs will be dismissed from the rooms as stated on the form.
8. Please do not forget to indicate if your child will be collected or is able to walk home alone. **Year 1, Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4 children must be collected by a responsible adult.**
